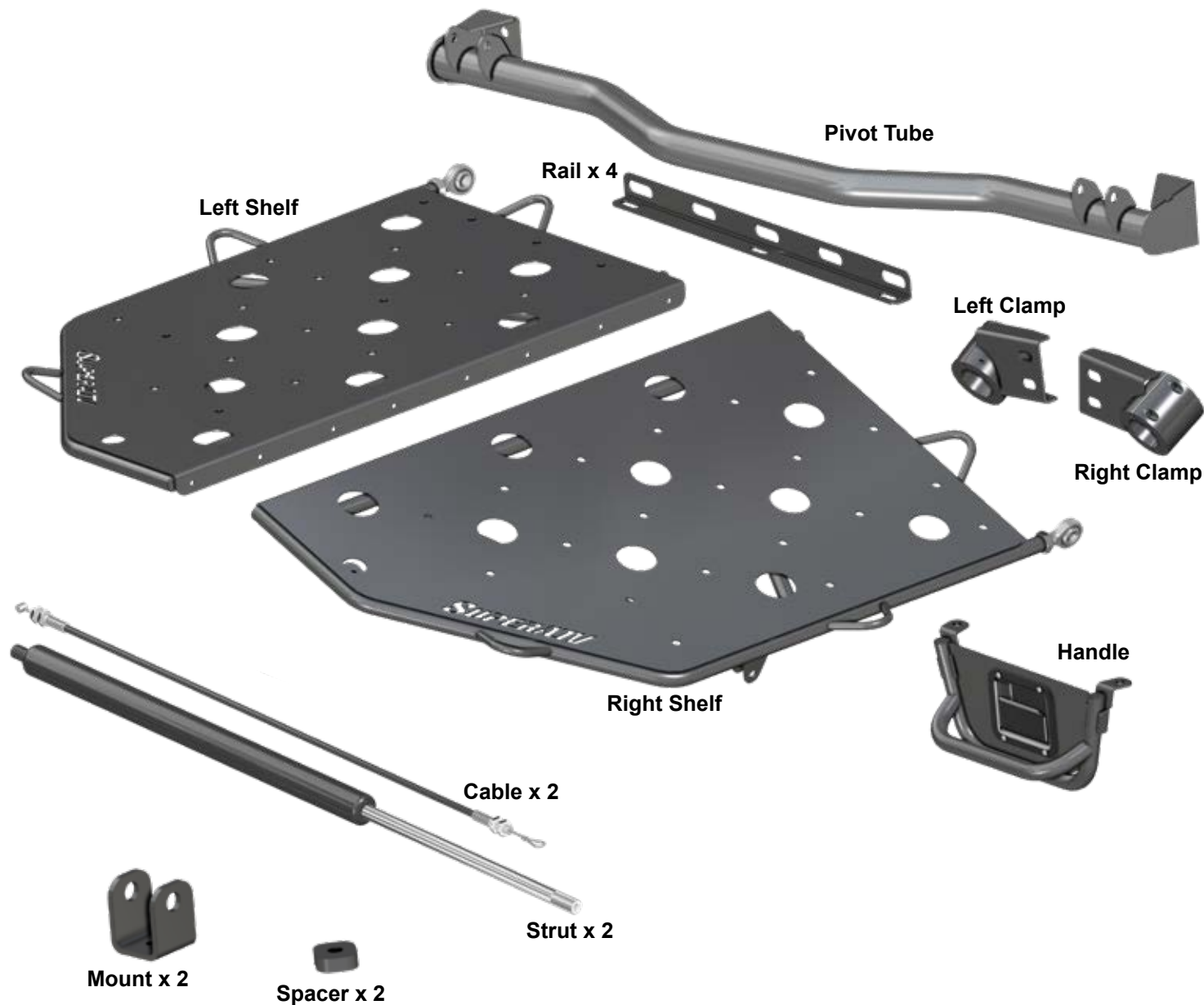

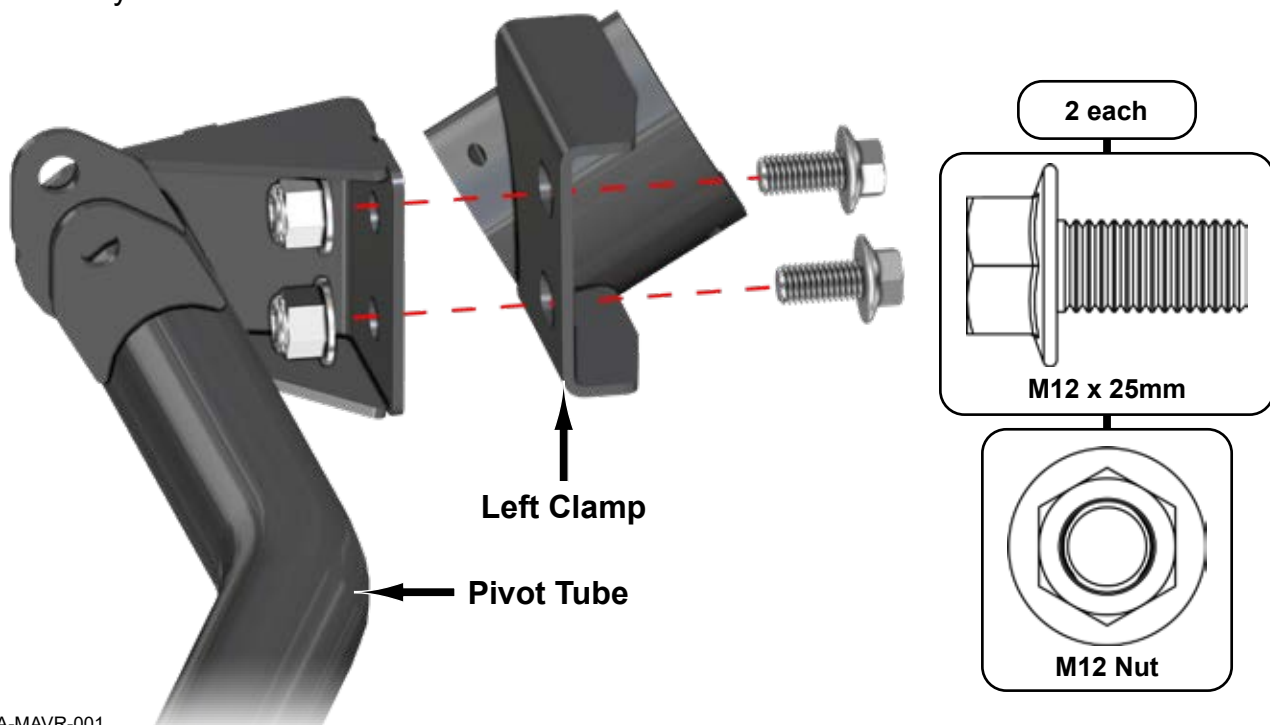

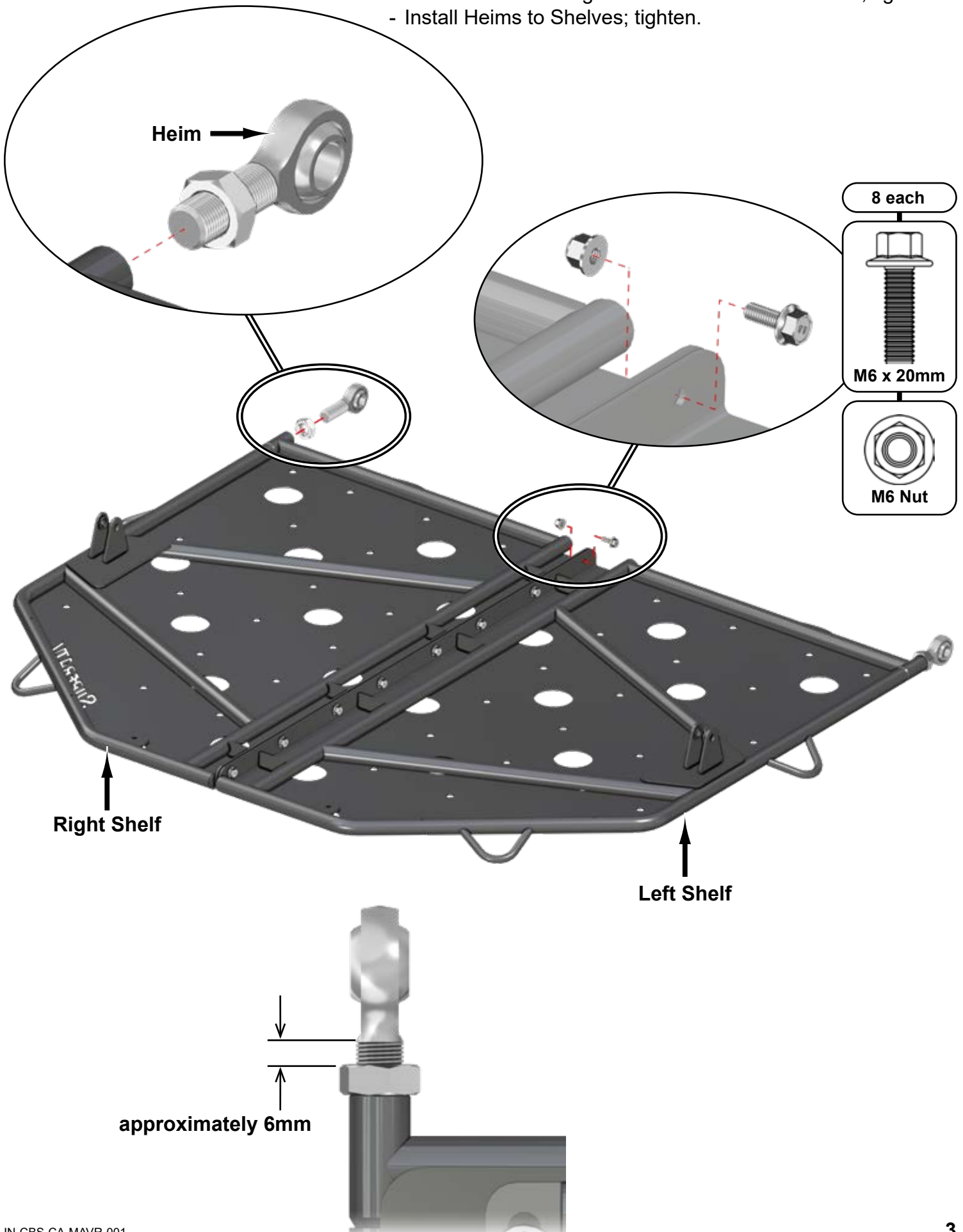
- Separate Clamp half from Left / Right Clamps and set aside.



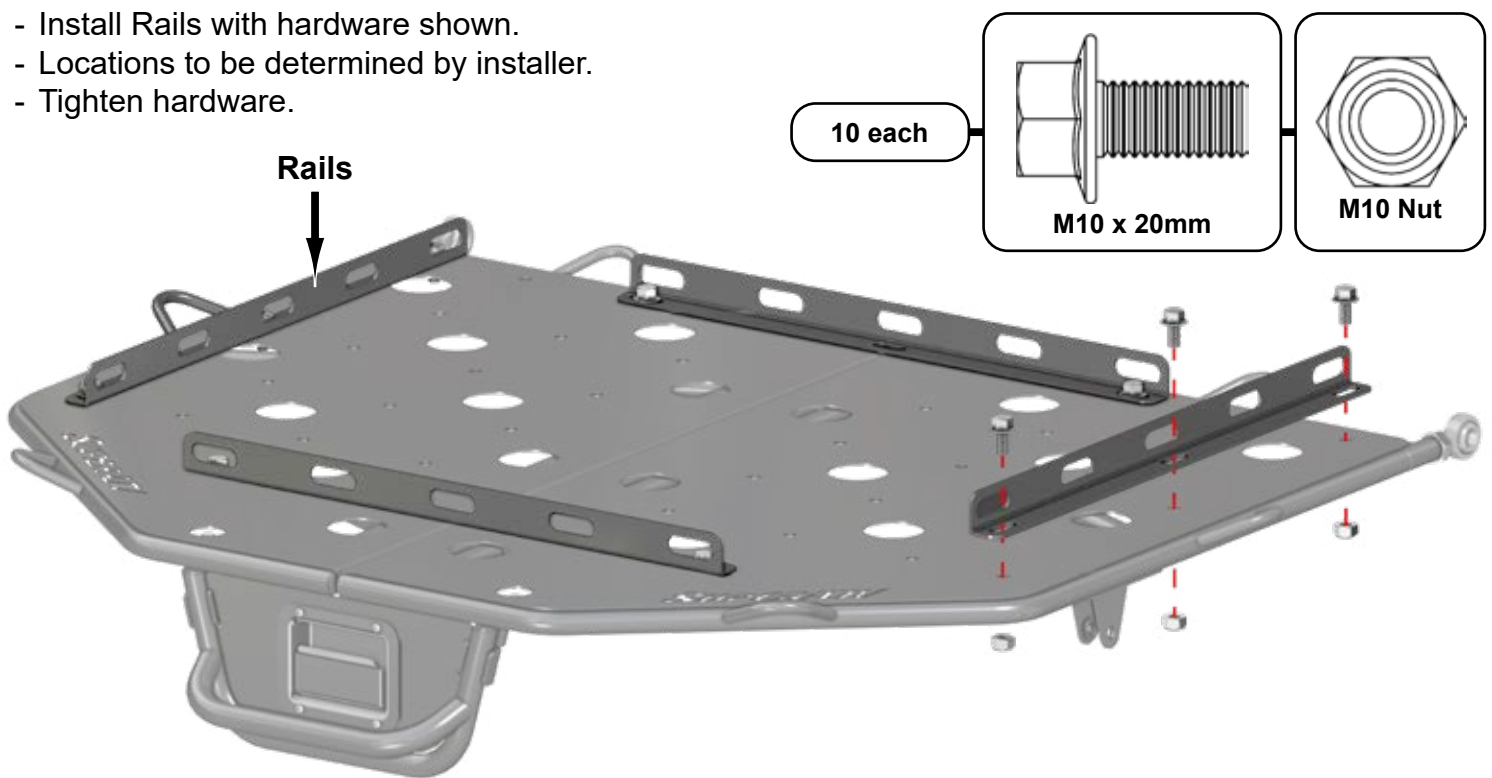
- Install Left Clamp and Right Clamp to Pivot Tube with hardware shown; do not tighten.
- Set assembly aside.



- Join Left Shelf to Right Shelf with hardware shown; tighten.
- Install Heims to Shelves; tighten.

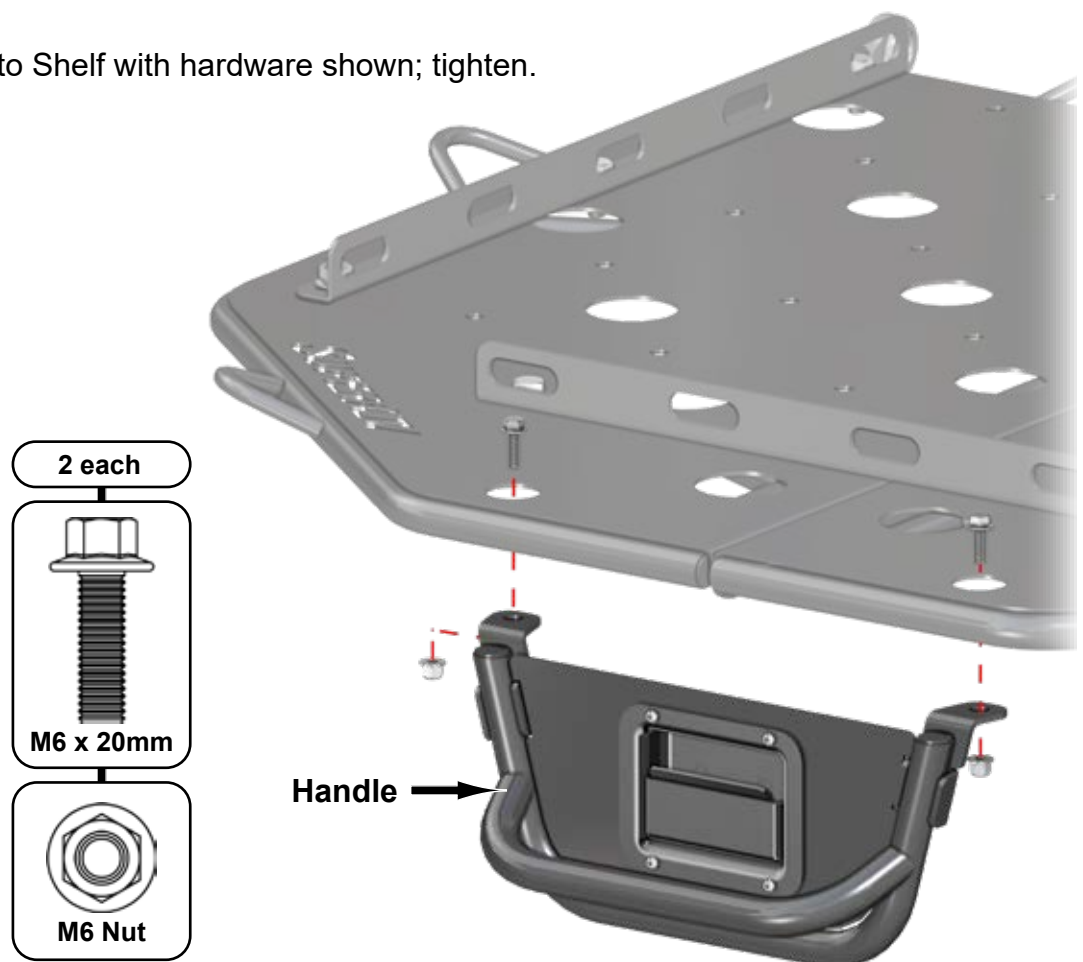


- Install Rails with hardware shown.
- Locations to be determined by installer.
- Tighten hardware.

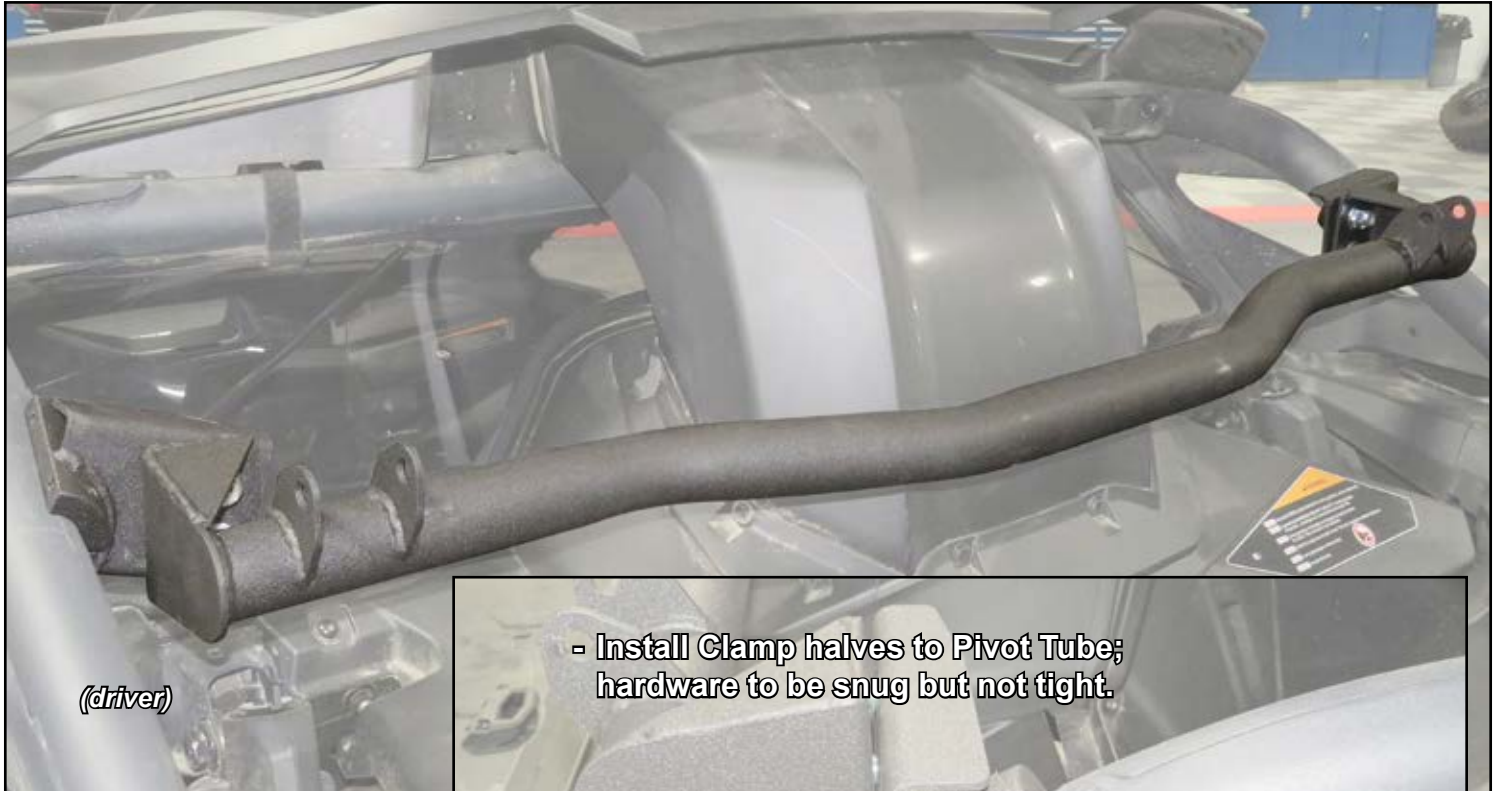


(use 3 sets of hardware for side Rails installation)

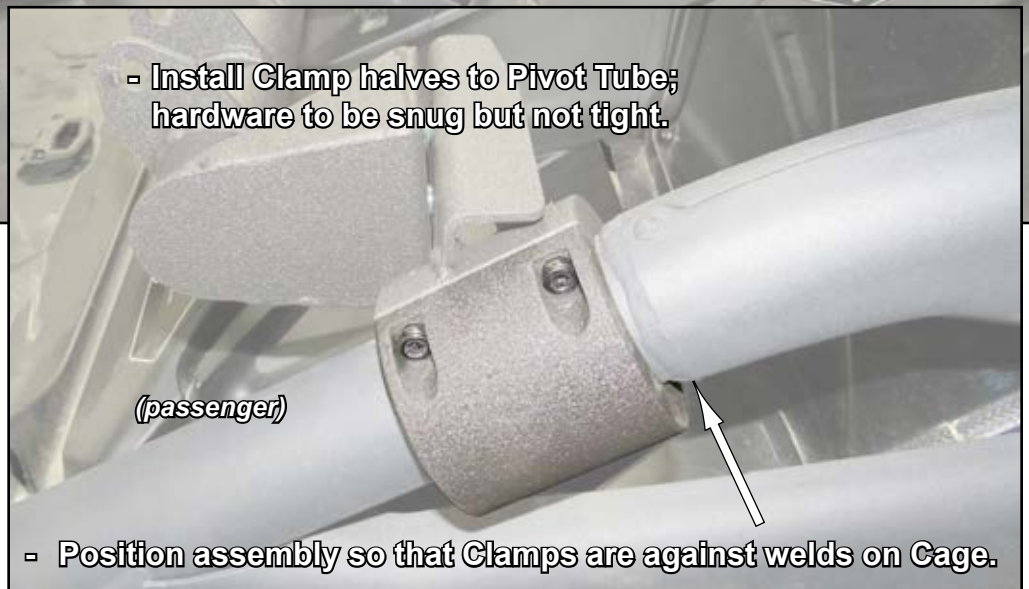
- Install Handle to Shelf with hardware shown; tighten.



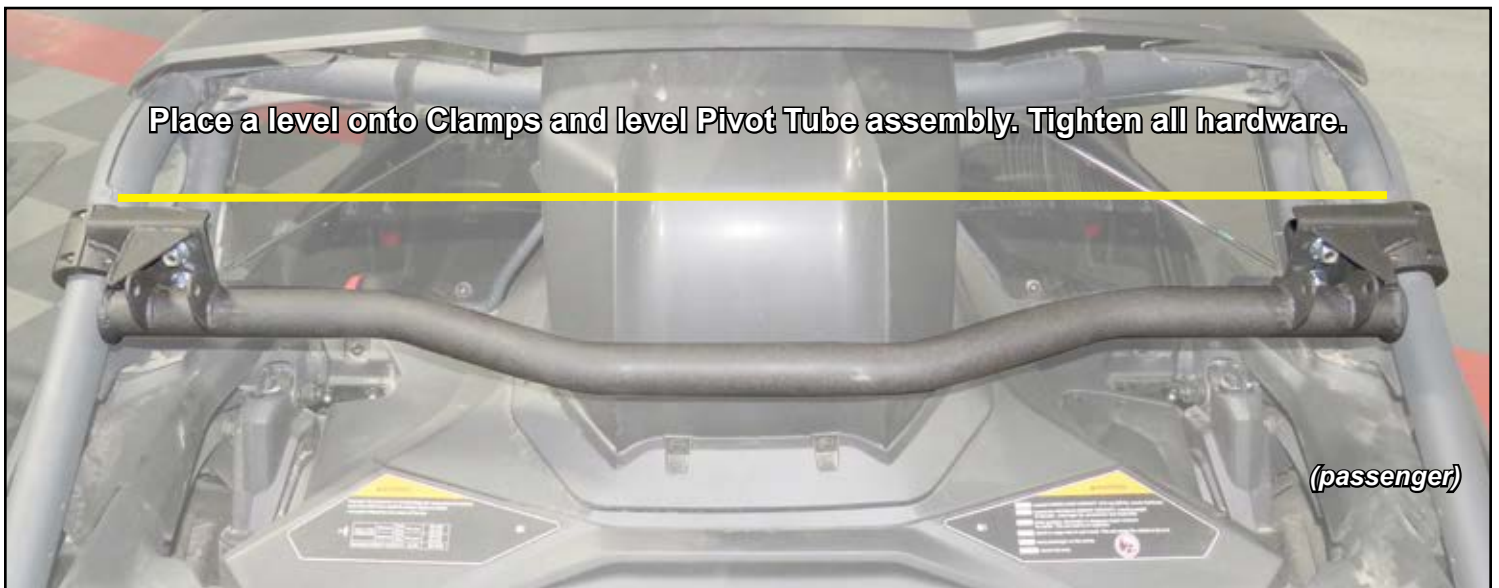
- Place Pivot Tube onto machine.

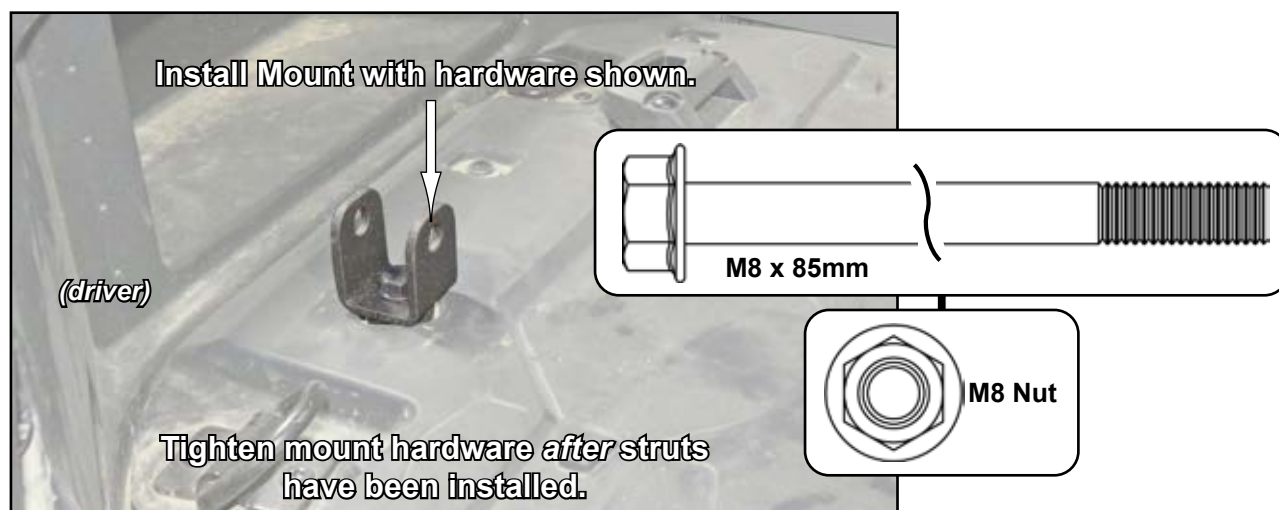


- Install Clamp halves to Pivot Tube; hardware to be snug but not tight.



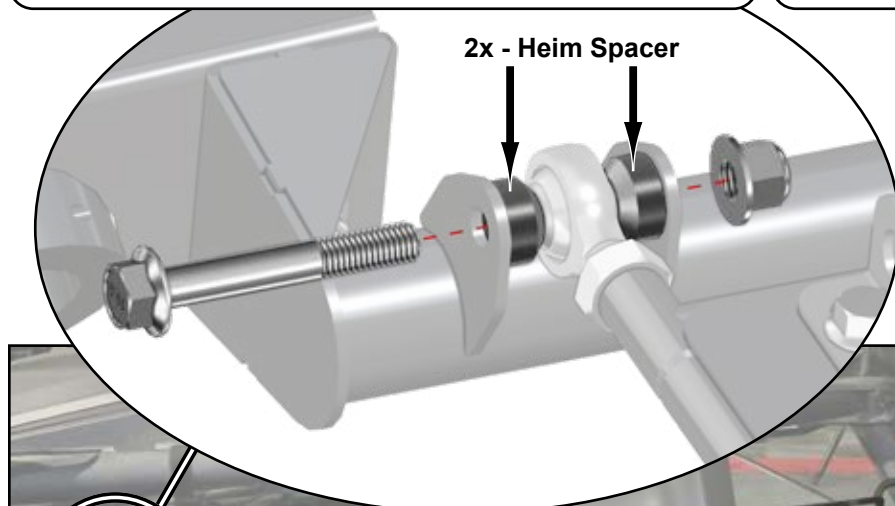
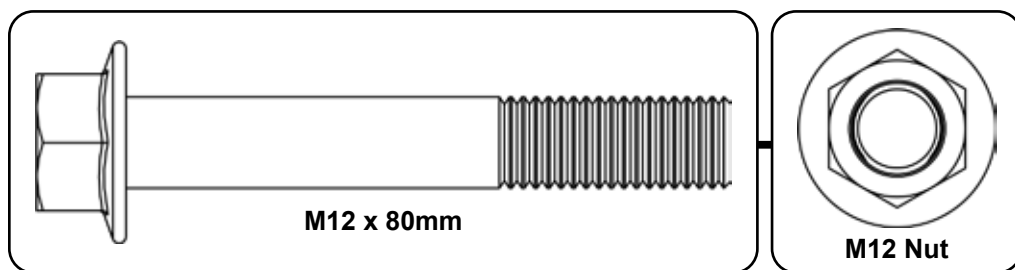
Place a level onto Clamps and level Pivot Tube assembly. Tighten all hardware.



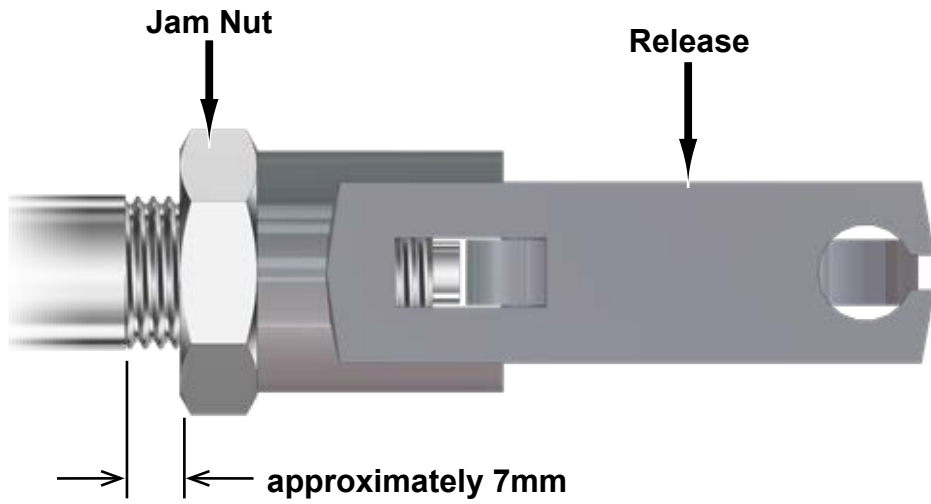


Repeat steps for passenger side.

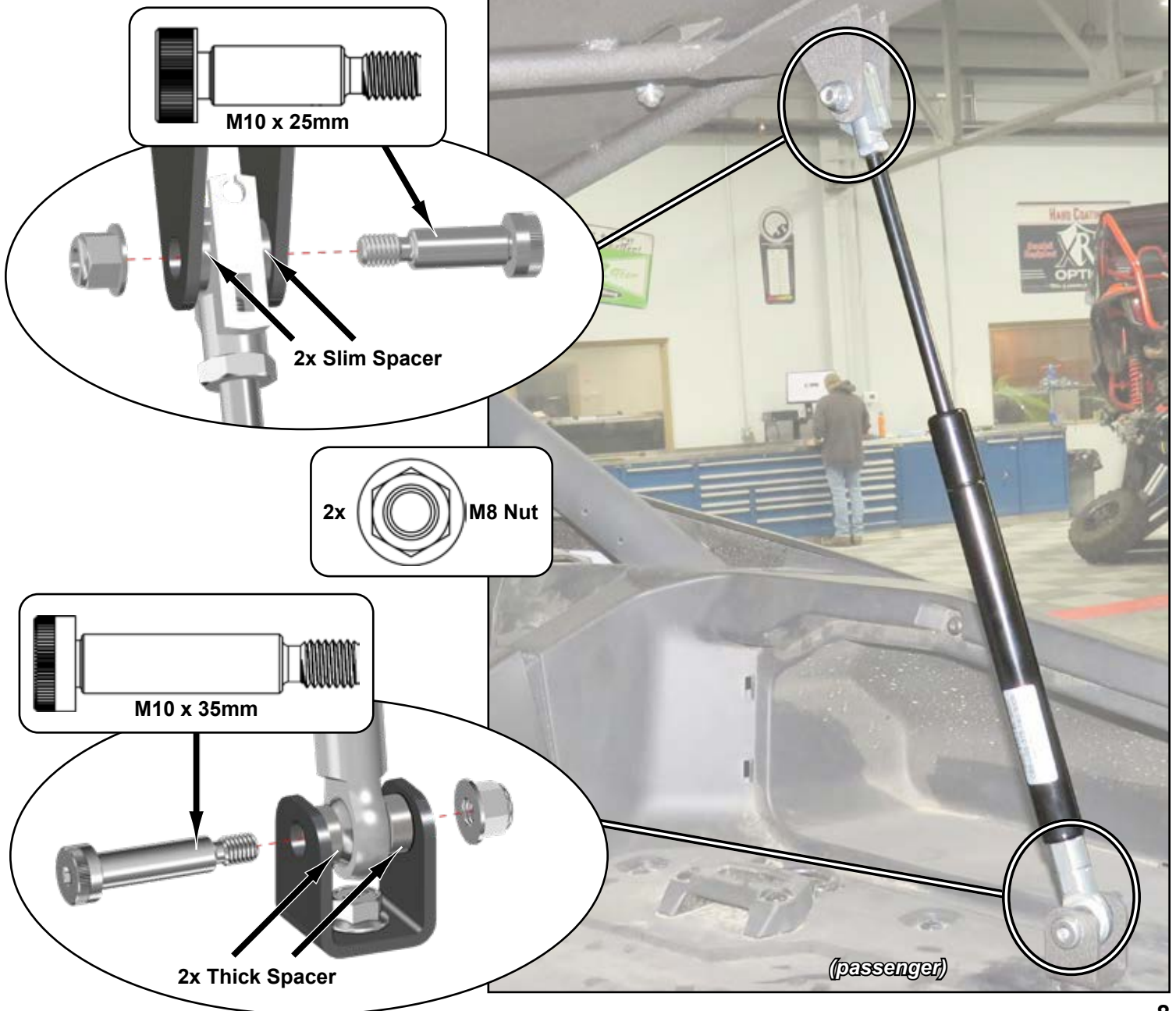
- Place Cargo Shelf onto machine and secure Heims to Pivot Tube with hardware and components shown; tighten hardware.



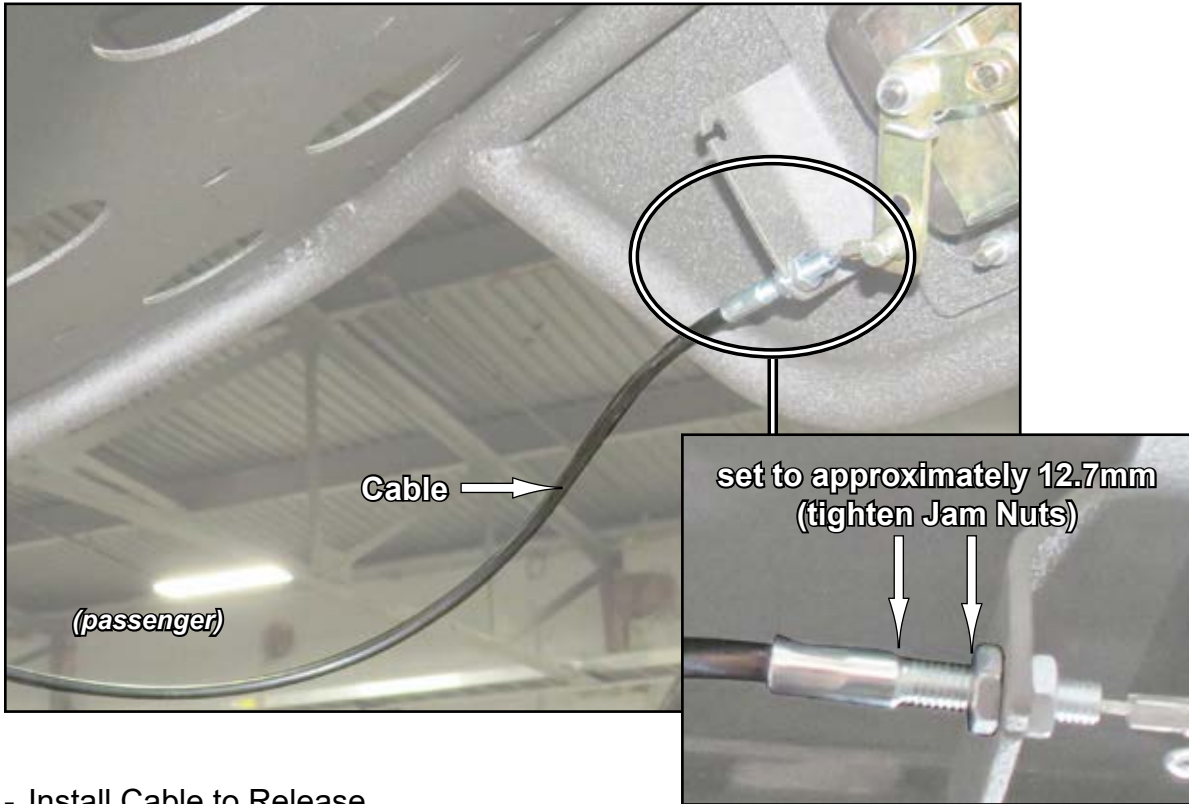
- Adjust Releases to approximate dimension shown; do not tighten Jam Nuts.



- Install Strut with hardware shown; tighten.
- Repeat for driver side.



- Install Cable to Handle.



- Install Cable to Release.



Repeat steps for passenger side.

- Secure Cables to Handle with components shown.



- When Handle is activated, Cables should release simultaneously.
- Cargo Shelf should lower evenly and smoothly if Cables are properly adjusted.
- Adjust Jam Nuts on Handle and Releases in small increments.
- Tighten Jam Nuts completely after all adjustments are final.

- Secure Cables to Shelves with components shown; tighten.
