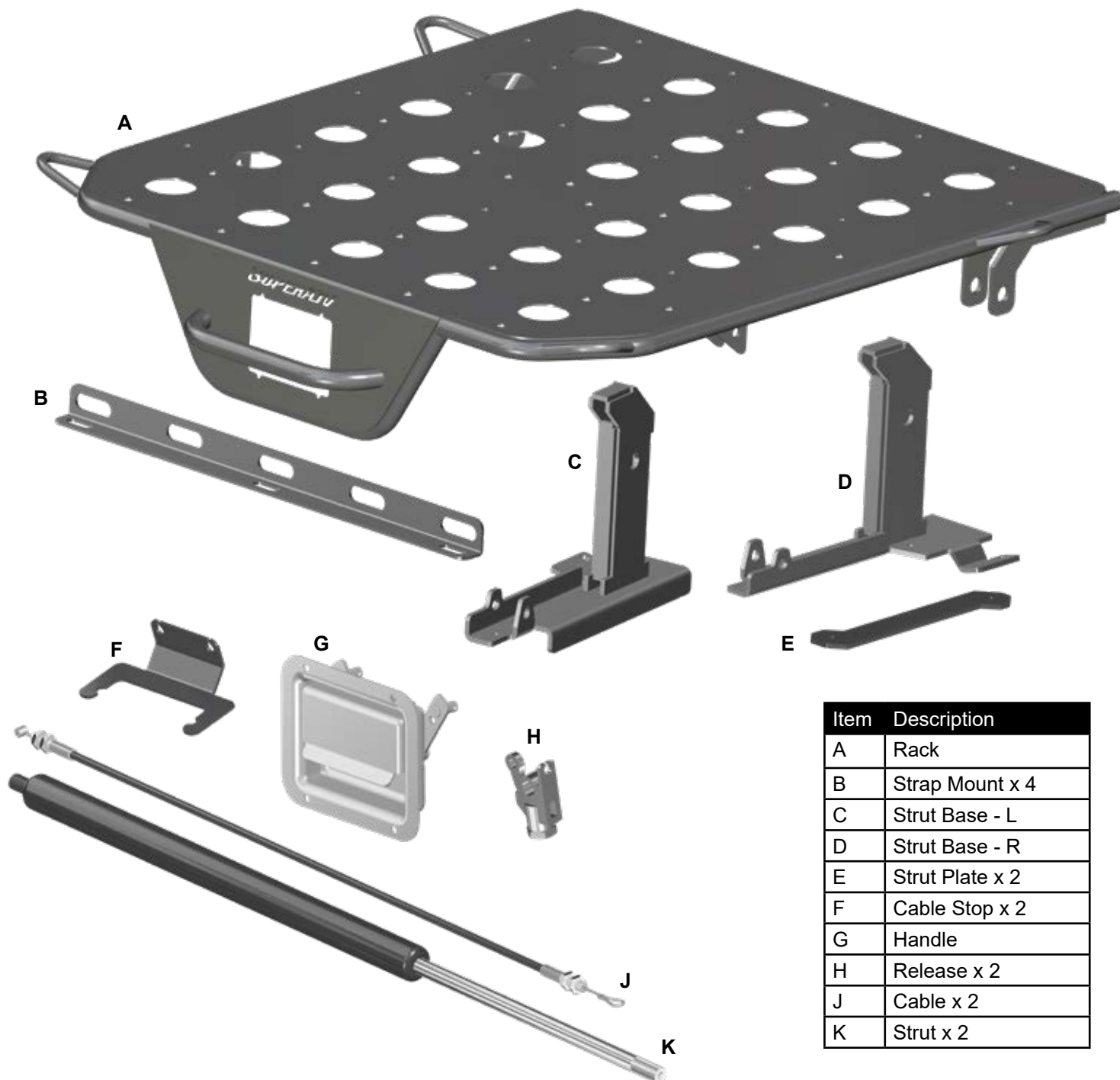


## INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

### Cargo Rack System: for Polaris RZR<sup>®</sup> XP

Do not discard packaging until product has been successfully installed.



| Item | Description     |
|------|-----------------|
| A    | Rack            |
| B    | Strap Mount x 4 |
| C    | Strut Base - L  |
| D    | Strut Base - R  |
| E    | Strut Plate x 2 |
| F    | Cable Stop x 2  |
| G    | Handle          |
| H    | Release x 2     |
| J    | Cable x 2       |
| K    | Strut x 2       |

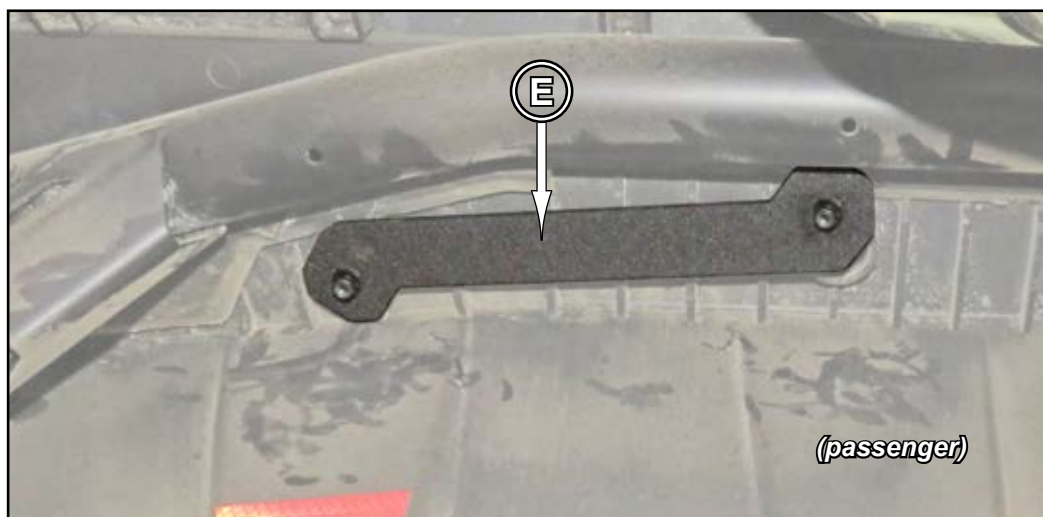
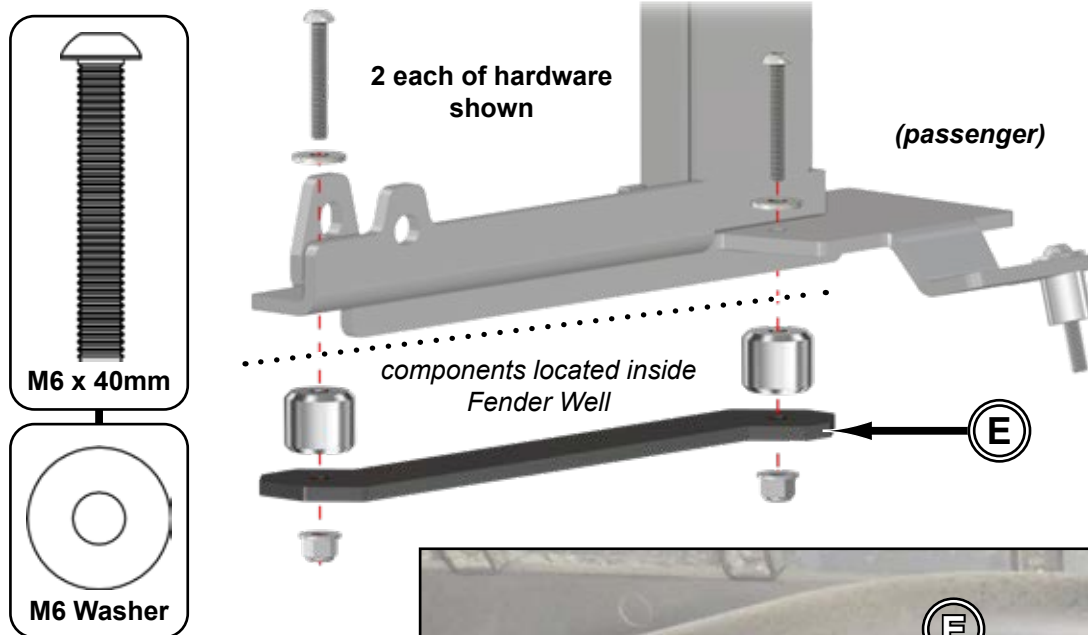
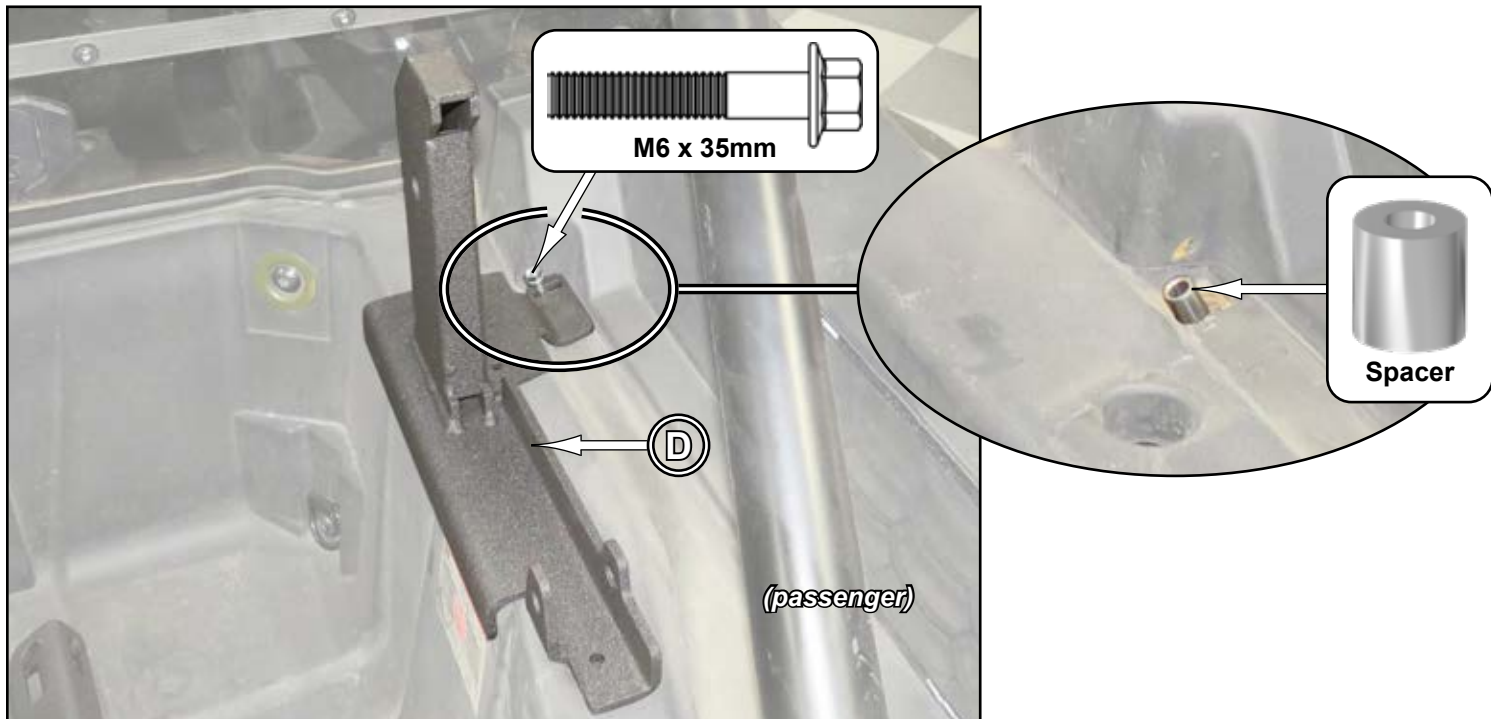
- Install Releases (H) and Nuts to Struts (K).
- Do not tighten.



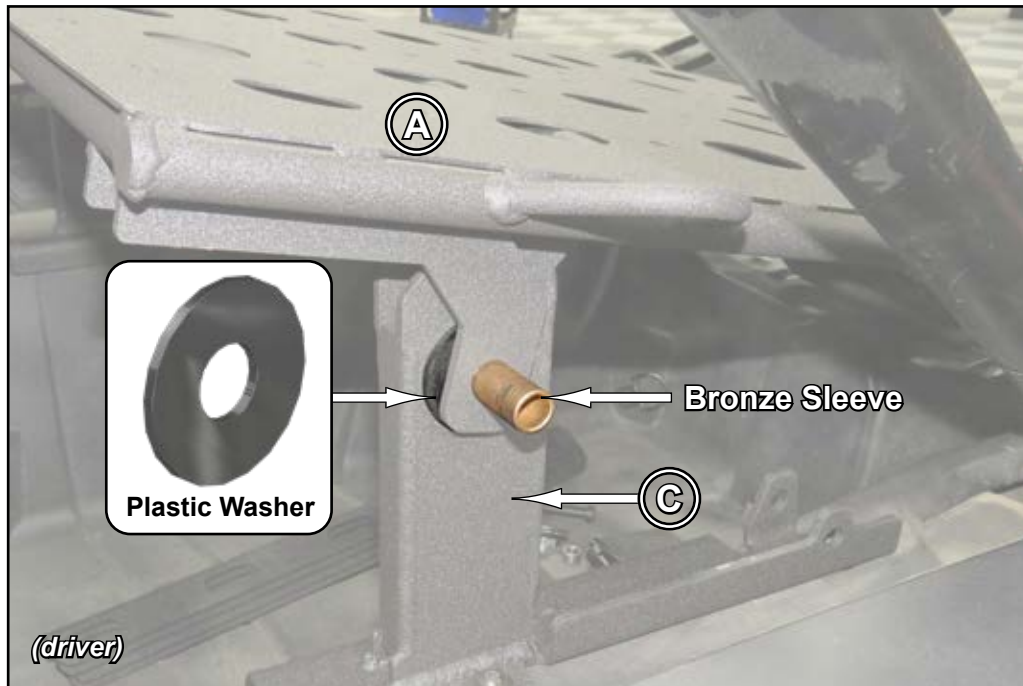
- Install Cables Stops (F) to Rack (A) with hardware shown; tighten.



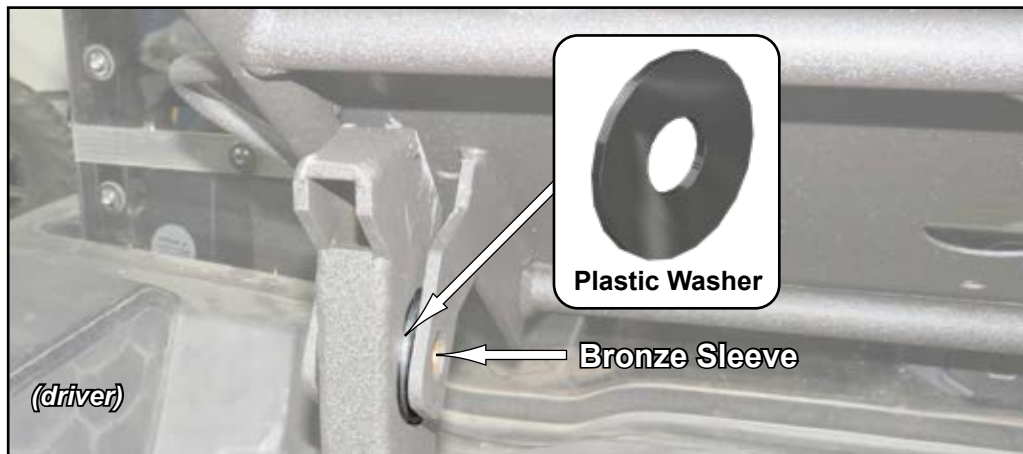
- Remove stock Screw and insert Spacer.
- Install Strut Base - R (D) and Strut Plate (E) with hardware shown; tighten.
- Repeat steps for driver side.



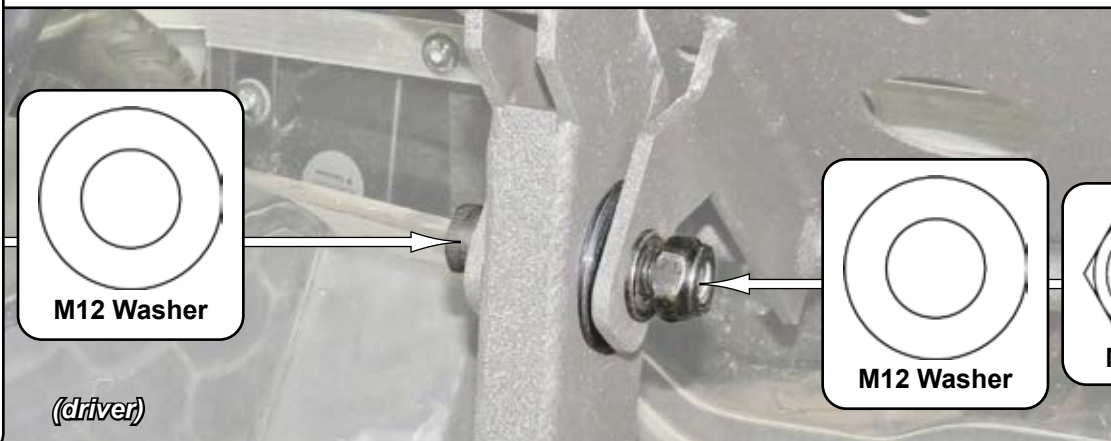
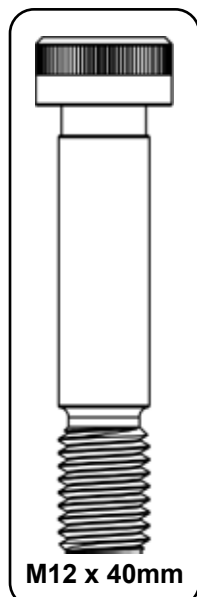
- Place Rack (A) onto Strut Bases.
- Install (1) Plastic Washer between Strut Brace - L (C) and Rack (A).
- Insert Bronze Sleeve as shown.



- Install (1) Plastic Washer between Strut Brace - L (C) and Rack (A).
- Push through Bronze Sleeve as shown.



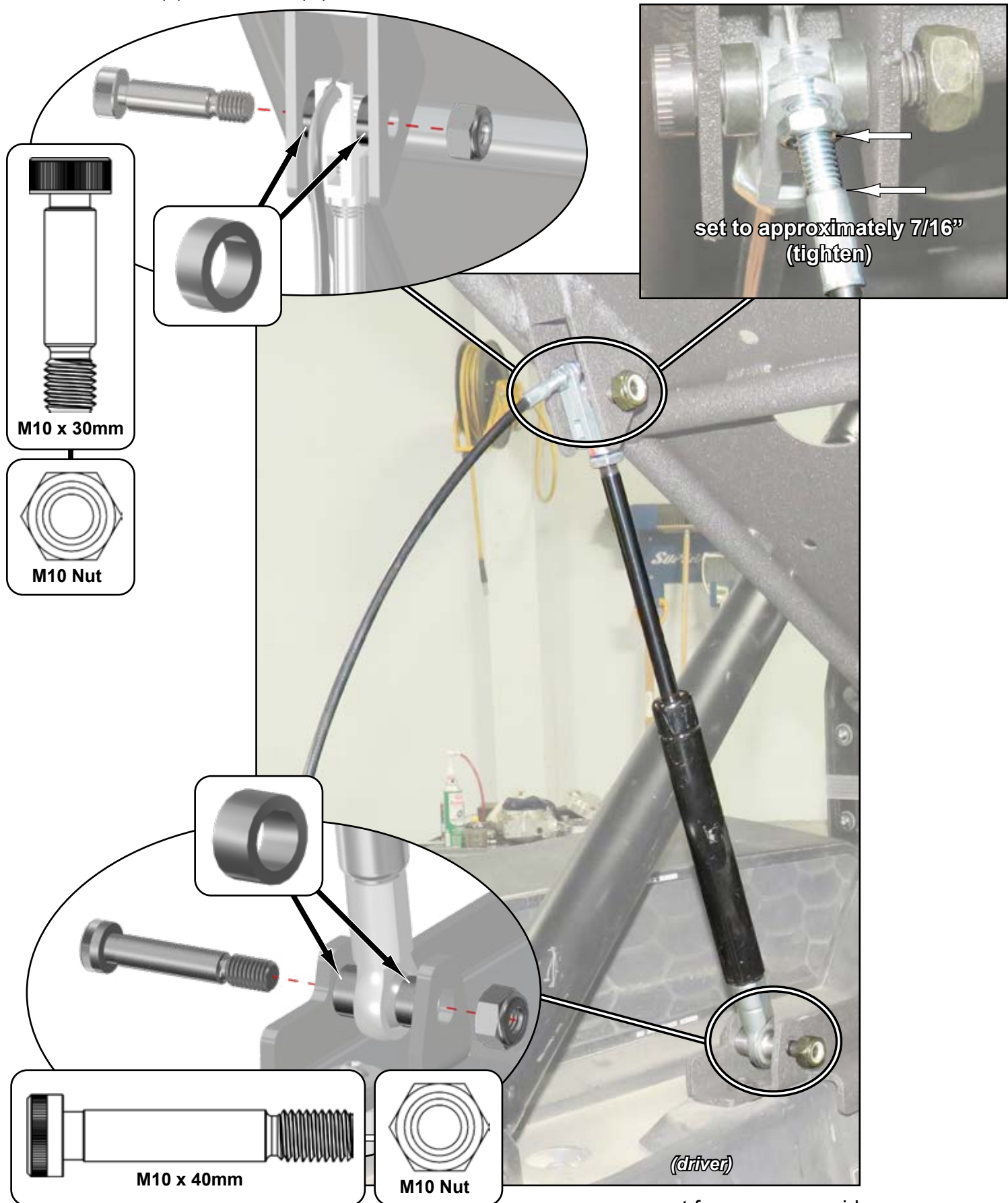
- Install hardware shown.
- Repeat for passenger side.



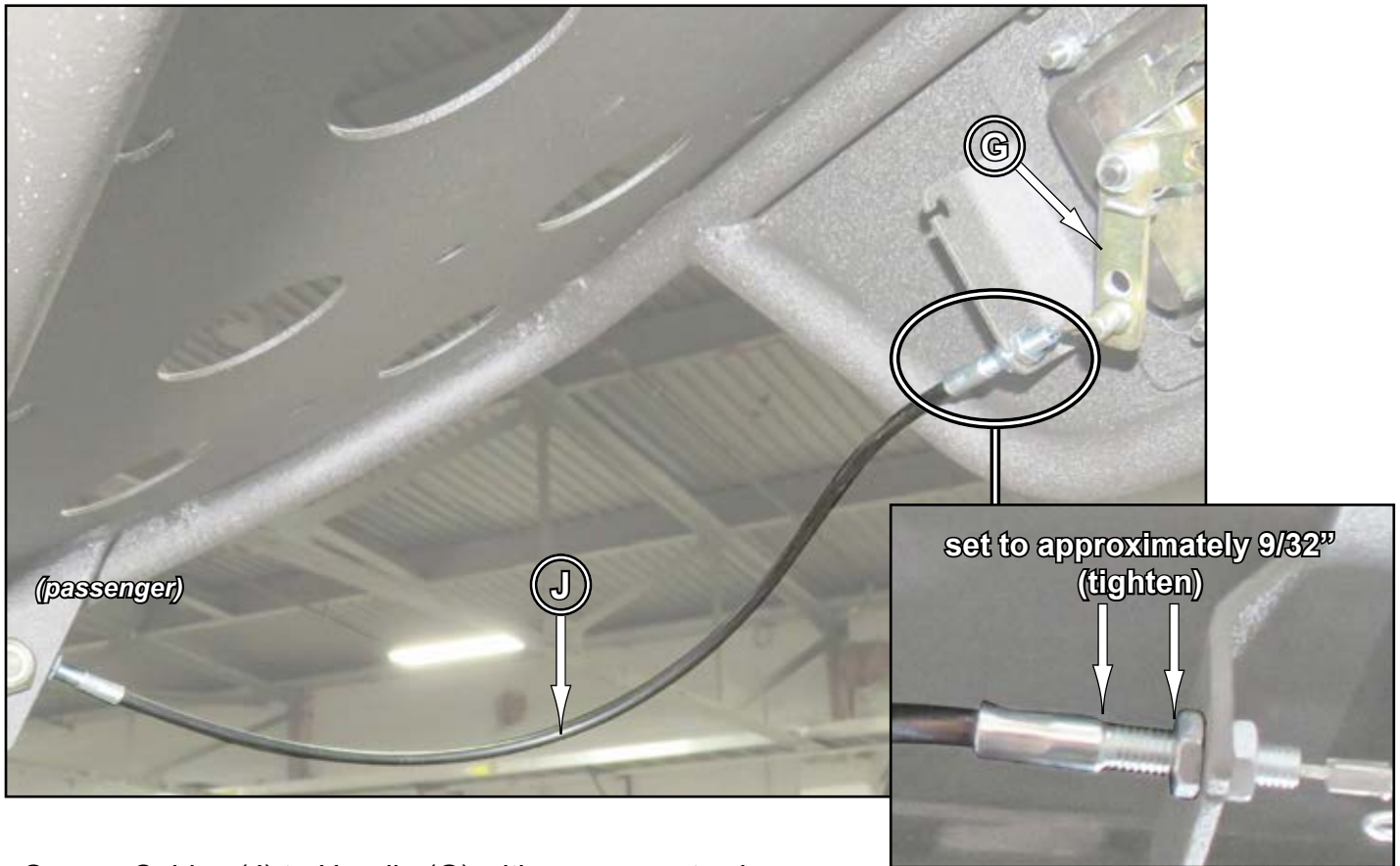
Tighten all hardware.



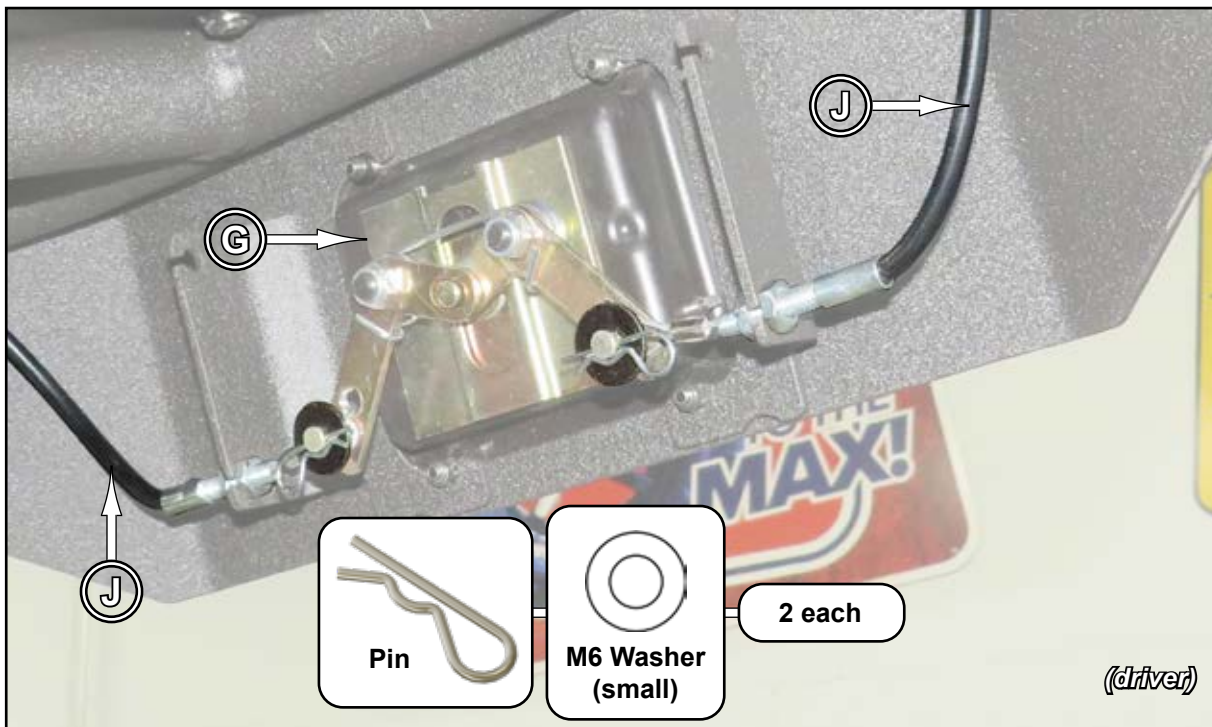
- Secure Strut (K) / Release (H) assembly to Rack (A) and Strut Base - L (C) with hardware shown; tighten.
- Secure Cable (J) to Release (H).



- Secure Cables (J) to Handle (G).

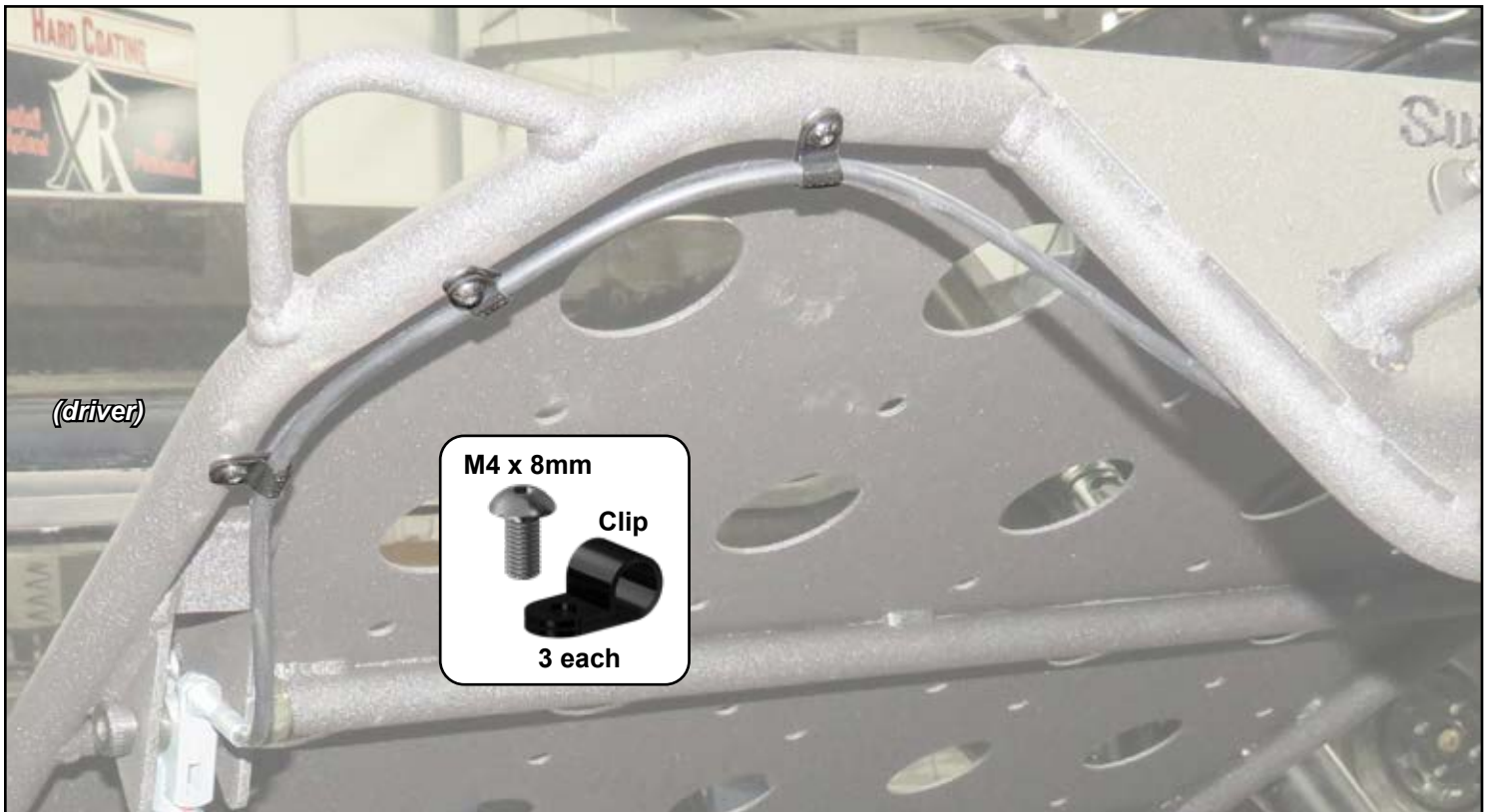


- Secure Cables (J) to Handle (G) with components shown.



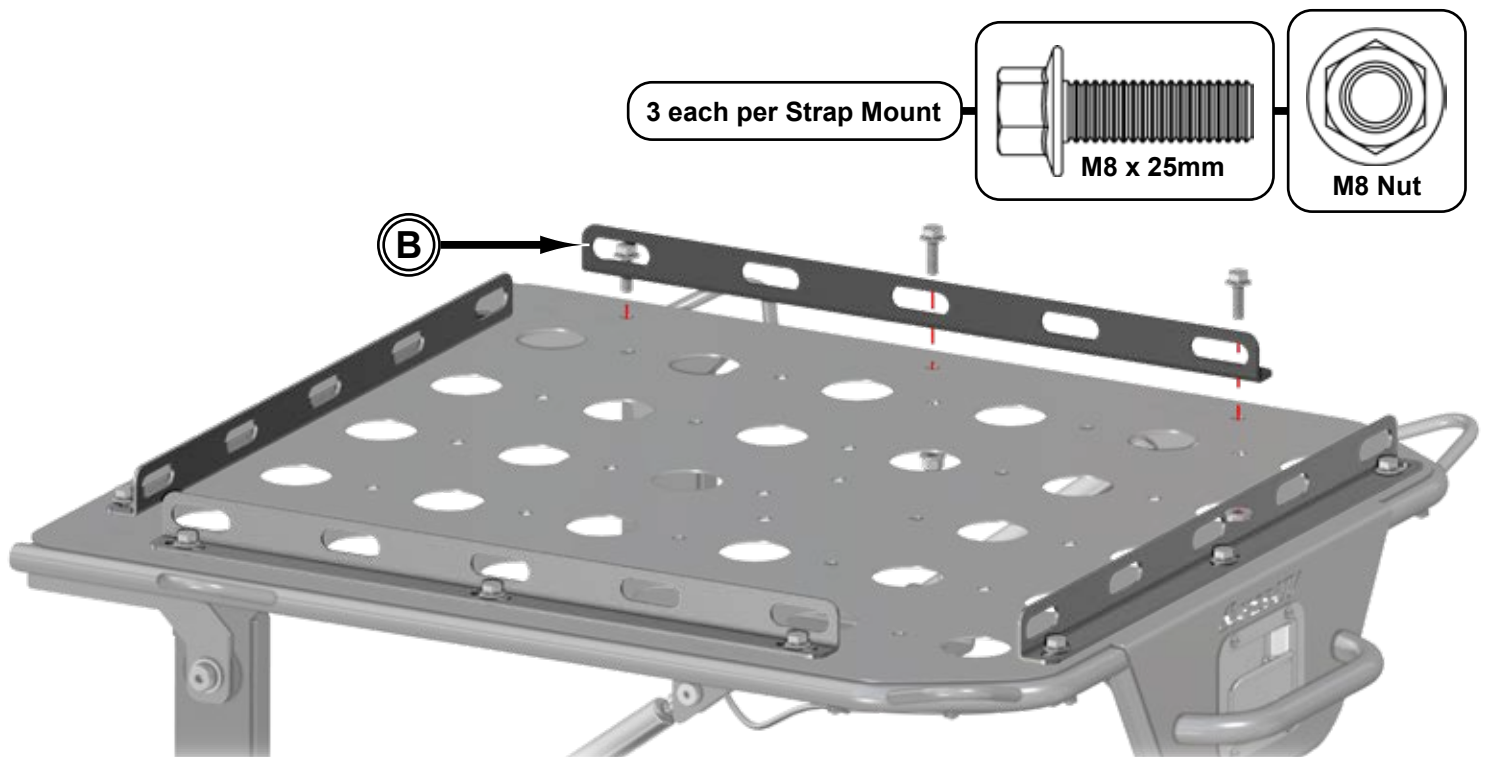
- When Handle (G) is activated, Cables (J) should release simultaneously.
- Cargo Shelf should lower evenly and smoothly if Cables (J) are properly adjusted.
- Adjust Jam Nuts on Handle and Releases (H) in small increments.
- Tighten Jam Nuts completely after all adjustments are final.

- Secure Cables (J) to Rack (A) with components shown; tighten.
- Repeat for passenger side.



Multiple Strap Mount (B) configurations are possible. Install where desired.

- Install Strap Mount (B) to Rack (A) with hardware shown; tighten.



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
