Power Flip Windshield: for Can-Am Defender

- Do not discard packaging until product has been successfully installed.
- While routing wires, follow factory wiring when possible and avoid rotating and/or hot components.
- Use provided wire ties and secure wires and Harnesses as needed.
- SuperATV does not recommend keeping Windshield installed while transporting on an open air trailer. Remove or secure with straps.












- Remove Fender from machine.
- Repeat for passenger side.




- Remove Multi Purpose Support from machine.
  - ★ Spacers will fall out of machine when removing Multi Purpose Support hardware. Follow steps shown when reinstalling Multi Purpose Support.




- Install Hinges (B) to Windshield (A) with hardware shown.
- Tighten hardware.





- User may install Switch in location different than shown.
- Verify that Harnesses will reach Switch before mounting.
- Remove stock Knockout or cut a new location. *If cutting a new location, check behind area to be cut for any interference.*
- Connect wiring and secure Switch.

# Before permanently mounting Switch, SuperATV recommends testing after all components have been installed.



- Connect Power Harness to stock Bus Bar as shown.



## **Power Harness Wiring**






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
- Place Windshield (A) onto machine.
- Secure Hinges to machine; do not tighten.



- Secure Actuator (J) to Windshield (A) with hardware shown; tighten.
- Repeat for passenger side.




- Route Actuator connection from Harness to Actuator.





- Pass wiring through hole and connect Acuator to Harness.



- Repeat steps for driver side.



- Place Actuator Wire into Wire Guide (C) and secure Wire Guide (C) to machine as shown.



Reinstall all previously removed stock components.
